The Châtelain family, Amsterdam atlas compilers and publishers, was founded by Zacharie, who died 1723. His sons Henri Abraham (1684-1743) and Zacharie Jr. (1690-1754) are best known for compiling (*using primarily maps by Delisle*) and publishing their "Atlas Historique" under a variety of imprints from 1705 - 1739. (*The specific information about Volume IV's publishing history is from a 2010 article by Jan W. van Waning in IMCoS # 120.*)

There are only two valid publish dates for

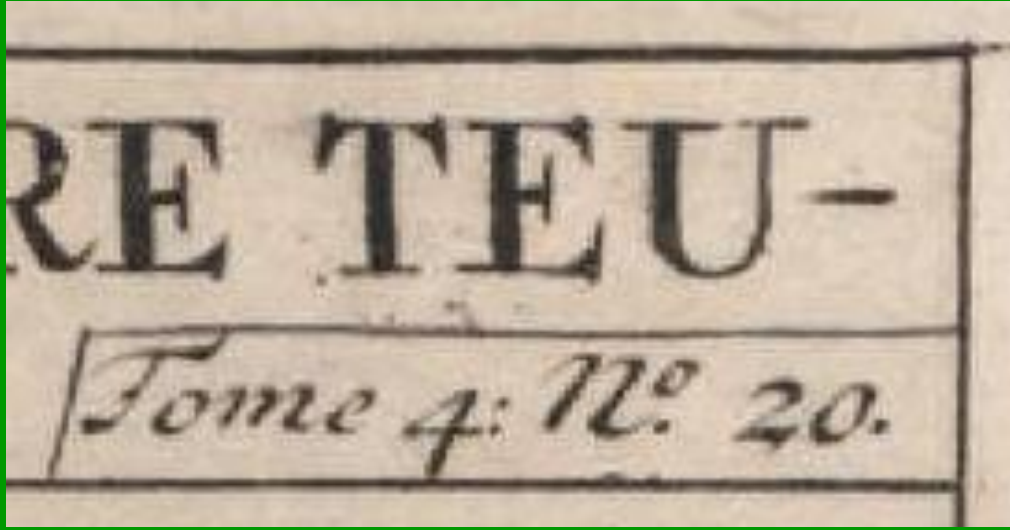

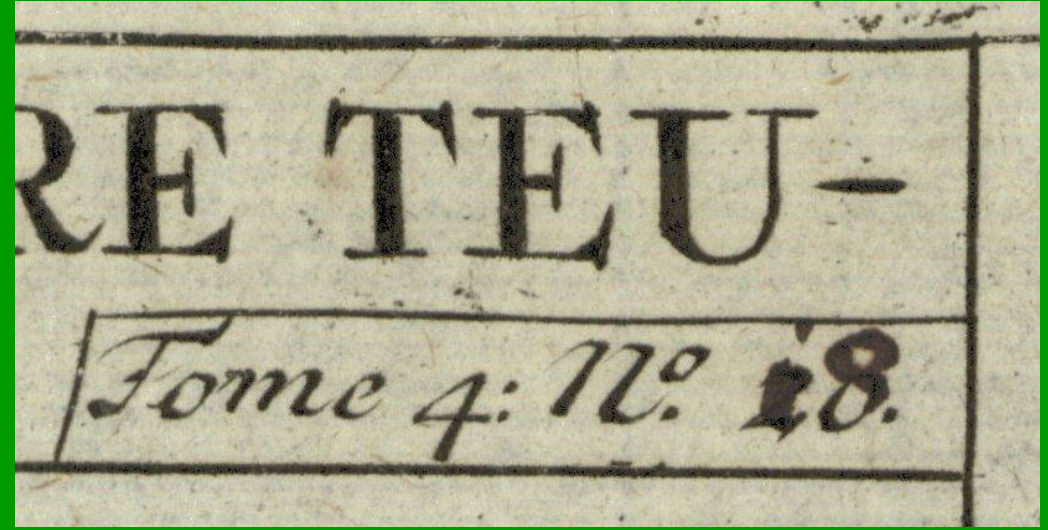
